

Division Description

- Model Class - Open to any Horse or Pony to be shown in hand and trotted at judges request. To be judged on hunter type and conformation.
- Lead Line - Open to riders 6 and under, side walkers are allowed. To be judged on equitation.
- Walk - Open to riders 9 and under. To be judged on equitation
- Walk Trot (10 and Under)- Open to any rider 10 or under not showing at a canter.
- Walk Trot (11 and over) - Open to any rider 11 or over not showing at a canter.
- Green Horse - Open to any horse or pony in their first or second year of showing not showing Over Fences.
- Pleasure Horse- Open to any horse/rider team not showing over fences. To be judged on horse's way of going.
- Warm up- Continuous warm up class over fences to be run all day in both rings.
- Crossrails- Open to any rider not showing over crossrail height.
- Short/Long Stirrup – Open to novice riders not showing over 18”
- Baby Green- Open to any horse or pony not showing over 18” in their 1st or 2nd year of showing.
- Schooling Hunter 18” – Open to any horse or rider. Height set at 18”
- Schooling Hunter 2’-2’3” –Open to any horse or rider. Height set at 2’- 2’3”
- Open Equitation- Open to any rider not showing over 2’6”. Jumps to be set at 2’ or 2’3”
- Children’s Pony Hunter- Pony heights must be declared on entry form. Riders may jump 2’ or 2’6” but if showing in the Classic and Medal you must show at required height for pony size. Small Ponies are 12.2 Hh or under showing at 2’ with a rider under 12 years; Medium Ponies are 12.3Hh-13.2Hh showing at 2’ with a rider under 14 years; Large Ponies are 13.3Hh-14.2Hh showing at 2’6” with a rider under 18 years. Ponies are subject to being measured for height if so deemed necessary by Show Management. Rider’s age as of September 5 2010 shall be their age for remainder of the show season.
- M&S Children’s Pony Classic- Above height/age restrictions are in affect. Class 24 will count as 1st round of the classic. To be judged on pony’s way of going.
- M&S Children’s Pony Medal – Above height/age restrictions are in affect. To be judged on rider’s equitation.
- Mod. Hunter Derby- Open to any Rider competing over 2’, the top six entries from class 37 will return for class 37a. Scores from class 27 will only determine the order of go for class 37a and will not determine final placing. In the event of a tie, entries will be asked to complete a shortened round for a jump off. Hunter Classic course may consist jumps of at 2’6”- 2’9”. An in and out, bending lines, or a line with an unrelated distance. Handy Hunter course may consist of a trot jump, lead over a jump, in and out, or walk a jump.
- Low Hunter- Open to any rider not competing over 2’6”. Jumps set at 2’3”
- Pre Child/Adult Hunter - Open to any amateur rider not competing over 2’6”

M&S Bit O' Straw Classic – Open to any amateur rider not competing over 2'6", class 33 will count as the first round of the classic.

Child/Adult Hunter – Open to any amateur rider not competing over 3'

M&S Child/Adult Classic- Open to any amateur rider not competing over 3' class 37 will count as the first round of the classic.

M&S Child/Adult Medal – Open to any amateur rider not competing over 3' will be judged on rider's equitation.
